Administrator Report: Dr. C. Boyle

-Advised she's not the school's administrator, obviously still over the program & working closely to select school admin:

- -Applications/resumes have been received really good candidates
- -Regarding the name "Columbus Gifted Academy:"

That's the program name and it's not going to change.

The program is to be very direct about who they are...Cincinnati uses the "gifted" moniker, and the same holds true for similar schools throughout the state. Understands there is sensitivity about it.

"One of the beautiful things about this program, in addition to the academics, we will be able to address the social aspect of what it [giftedness] is. It's a difference in how we learn, it doesn't make us better or worse. Some kids and some families are much more comfortable with that than others, our goal is come to a place of understanding with that. Where we are today with our collective comfort level with our name, is very different from where we as a group will be later when we've had a chance to build on it with student/teacher and community education."

Spirit Wear: We may need to be a little more sensitive about mascot, motto the kids developed, etc., without being ashamed of the word 'gifted.'

The goal, to empower children to know and become comfortable with "This is who I am, this is part of me." Asked for patience as we begin that journey.

Member brought up that 'gifted' inordinately/unfairly applied to specific demographics, worried about marginalizing students of color. various backgrounds etc.

Dr. Boyle response: Definition of ability for gifted - the district population doesn't match who is currently designated, but based on the Ohio definition, giftedness is based on performance on the specific tests.

We can set the template for what gifted is, regardless of advantage, the idea is actively seeking to destroying the advantage. Currently the gifted population is 60% to 40% white vs non white pop.

Gifted and Talented Services is actively seeking to find students throughout buildings where there are a lower number of gifted students identified through student outreach.

Library/Tech:

- The district votes on the fiscal year budget (6/16)
- Every classroom will have a deskton
- A nice selection of Chromebooks for kids to use
- Hoping to pull out some tech surprises
- There is a sizable budget for the new library (\$75K,) two of the book vendors have wish lists/registries where people can donate money toward books or specific books, will decide on vendor soon.

Beautification Day:
